- A team Pit should be the work of student team members.





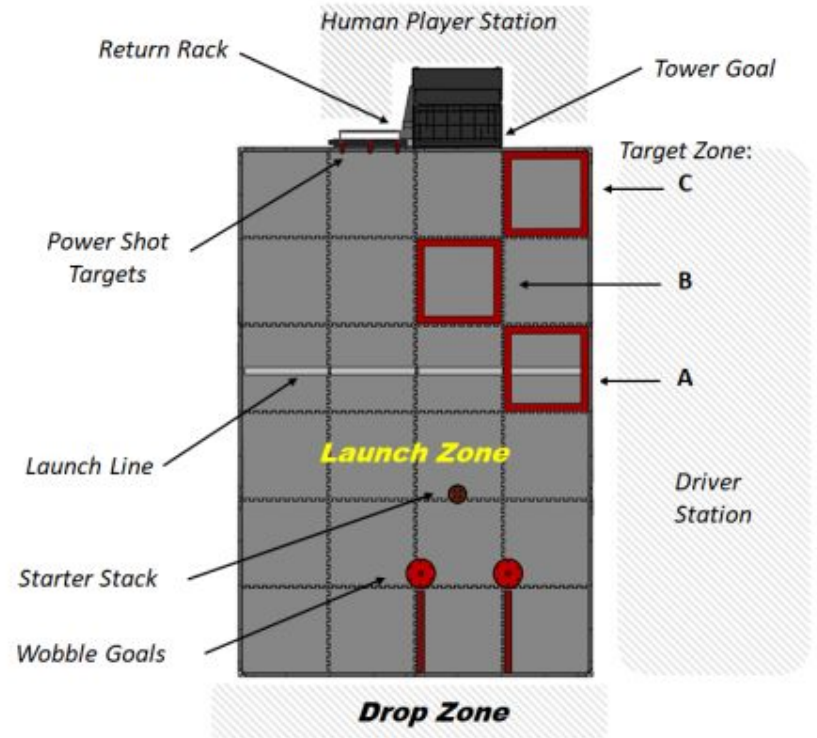

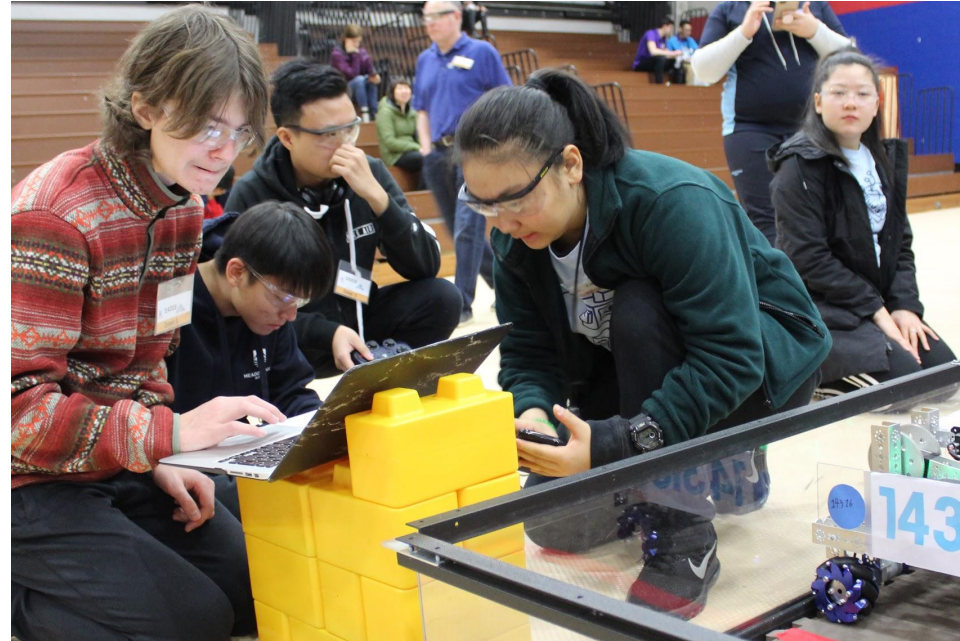
