Events - What to Bring

- Team Roster
- Safety Glasses for everyone with your team
- Robot, batteries, Driver station, Alliance Markers, Beacons
- Have the students review the <u>Robot Inspection</u> and the <u>Field</u> <u>Inspection</u> checklists. Inspections will go much faster if teams have already don't their own pre-inspection.

Have a plan for lunch or snacks. Most events don't have food available for purchase.





Robot Controller and Driver Station

- Please make sure you've updated to 8.0 or higher
- A new version of the Robot Controller app is being released this week. Most teams should not update to the newest version until after their first events!

Exception: Teams who purchased a control hub in the last 6 months who need to program with the IMU.

Even in this situation, if your team has found a way to make it work, don't update until after the events this weekend.


