




Robots

What is required on all FTC robots?









Robots

- Fit in 18" sizing cube
- Limits on electronics (max 8 DC motors, 12 servo motors)
- Must have a power switch
- No sharp edges & corners
- Team number & Alliance Markers
- Wiring: risk of tangle / safety & other requirements
