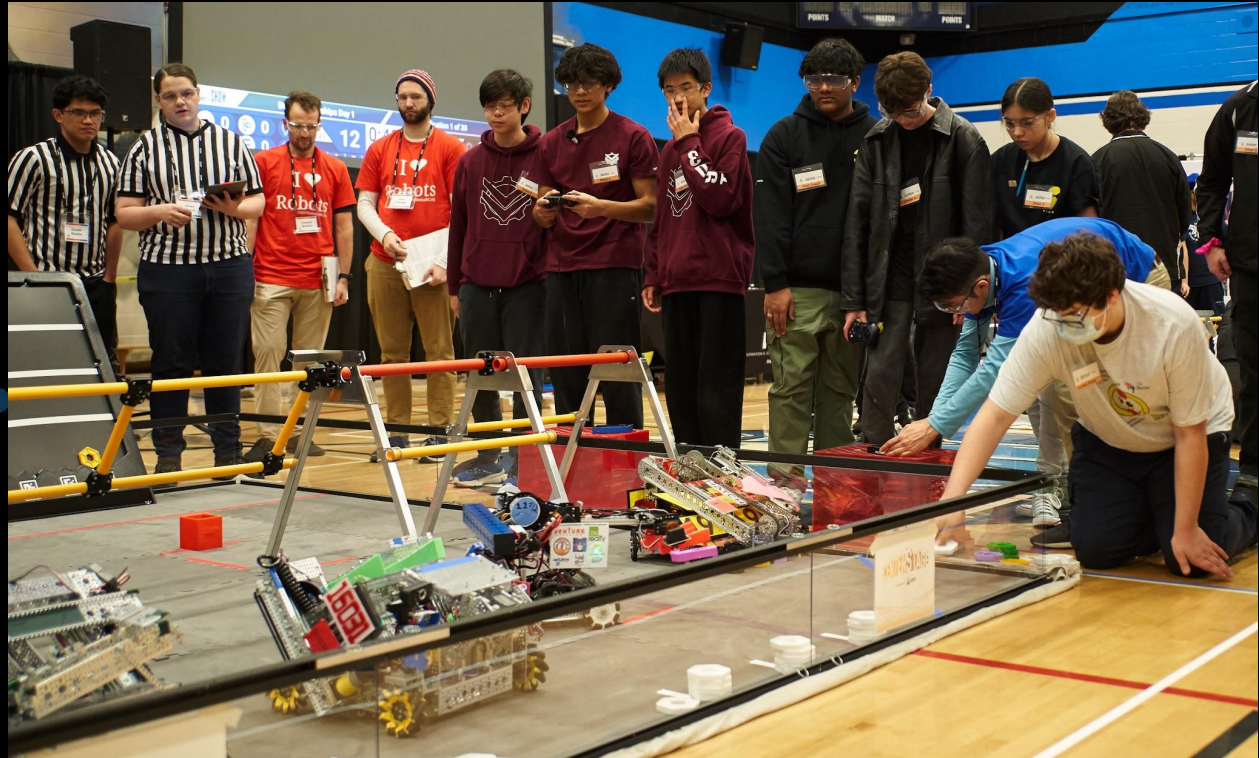

## Playoff Structure – new Double Eliminations

- Number of Alliances in the Playoffs scales with event size.
- 2 Team Alliances for all events.

| Total playoff eligible teams | Number of playoff ALLIANCES formed |
|------------------------------|------------------------------------|
| <b>4-10 Teams</b>            | 2                                  |
| <b>11-20 Teams</b>           | 4                                  |
| <b>21-40 Teams</b>           | 6                                  |
| <b>41-64 Teams</b>           | 8                                  |

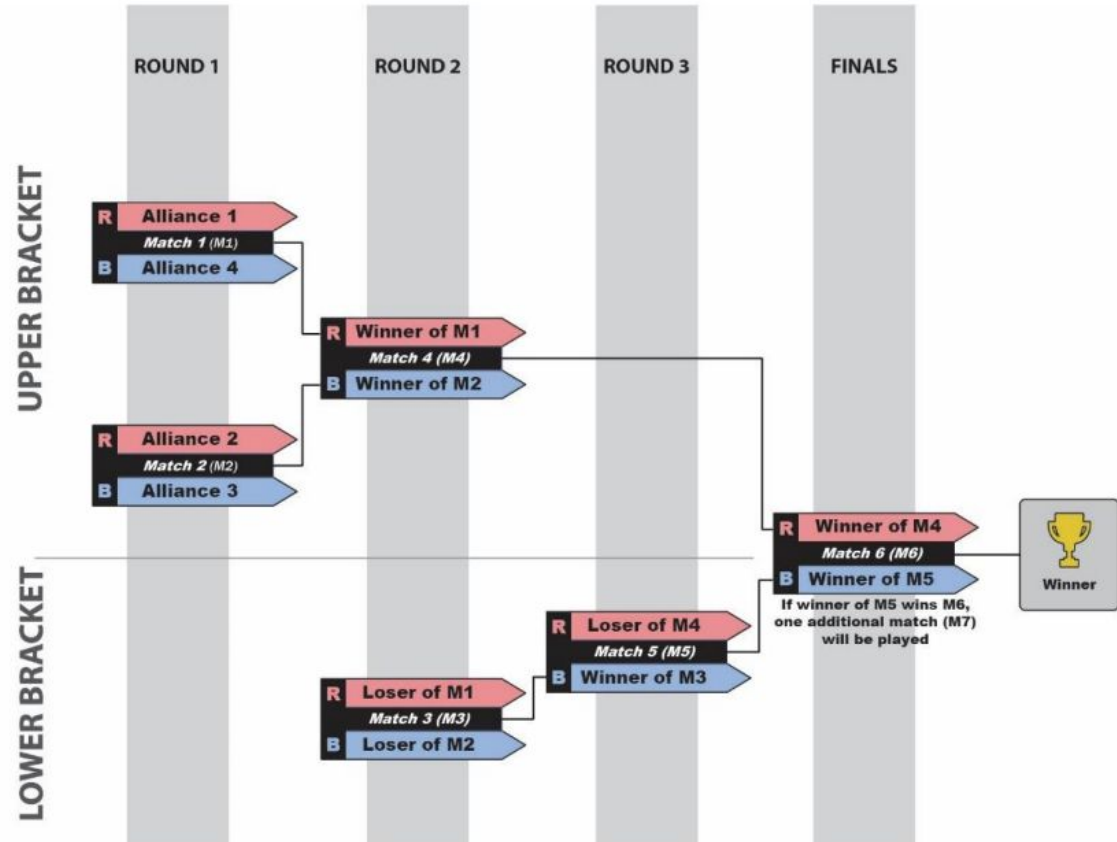
# What is a Double Elimination?

- Each alliance keeps playing until they have lost twice.
- In most playoff matches, an alliance will play against a different alliance in each match.

## What is Double Elimination?

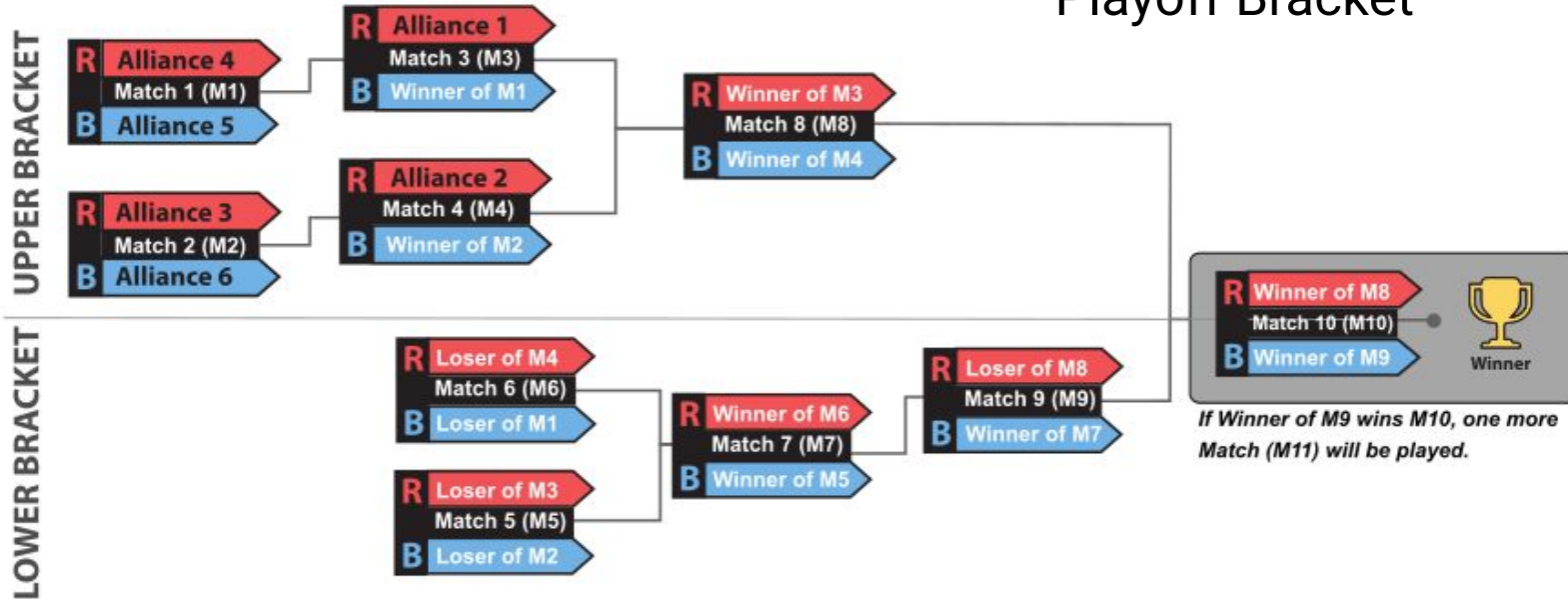
Example of 4 alliance Playoff Bracket

Each alliance will only play one match in each round.

## Event Specific Rules in British Columbia

- Pits - Teams will have a table and some floor space.
- Power Tools - No power tools are allowed in the Pits.  
Includes everything from small 3D Printers to soldering irons or battery operated screwdrivers.
- Pits will be closed during Opening Ceremonies to ensure that everyone hears safety and event announcements.



## Events in British Columbia

All Qualifiers will be capped at 20 teams.

A minimum of 6 teams will advance from in person Qualifiers.

Teams can compete at more than one Qualifier.

There will be no Dual Division Events (Section 13.7) or League Play Tournaments (Section 14) in BC this season.
