# Portfolio – No Longer a Hard Requirement for all Awards

- Judging is a process to celebrate the hard work of our teams.
- Allows for multiple ways for teams to communicate the information to judges.
- Engineering Portfolio is required to win Control, Think, or Inspire Awards.

## Awards and Judging Changes

- Control Award content is included within the 15-page limit of the Engineering Portfolio.
- No Promote Award.
- Portfolio is no longer a hard requirement for all awards. At an event, all teams are eligible to win some awards and be recognized.
- Recording audio or video is not permitted during interviews

## Judging Tips

- Gracious professionalism will be considered for all awards.
- Judges will expect all team members to be at the Judging interview.
- Judges like to hear from all team members during the interview.
- Submit a portfolio. It is your team's voice during judging deliberations.
- Judges may look at other printed material during a pit visit, but they are not allowed to take it with them.
