Hello Referees for the 2024/25 Submerged! FLL season.

If you are interested in refereeing this year, here are some resources to start reviewing. The materials are all available on the FIRST website in their resource library that I have linked to here: https://www.firstinspires.org/resource-library/fll/challenge/challenge-and-resources.

First off, please make sure you have created an account on the FIRST Dashboard and registered online for the events that you wish to volunteer for. You will be prompted to complete your annual consent forms and you may be required to complete the Youth Protection Screening. It does take a few days for the screening to be completed, so keep that in mind with respect to the timing of the events.

When you are logged into your FIRST Dashboard, you will also be able to enroll and take several training courses related to the volunteering with FIRST generally:

- Volunteering with FIRST; and,
- FIRST Data Privacy and Protection Training 2024-2025.

And then specifically for refereeing:

- 24-25 FIRST LEGO League Challenge Head Referee Training; and,
- 24-25 FIRST LEGO League Challenge Referee Training.

I encourage you to complete all these courses before your first event. They are all fairly short (15 mins or so) and do not cost anything.

Secondly, in preparation for your event, please download and review both the Submerged! Rule Guide and the in-season Updates sheet. These will give you the basic information about the setup or the models, playing field and scoring for the challenge game this year.
